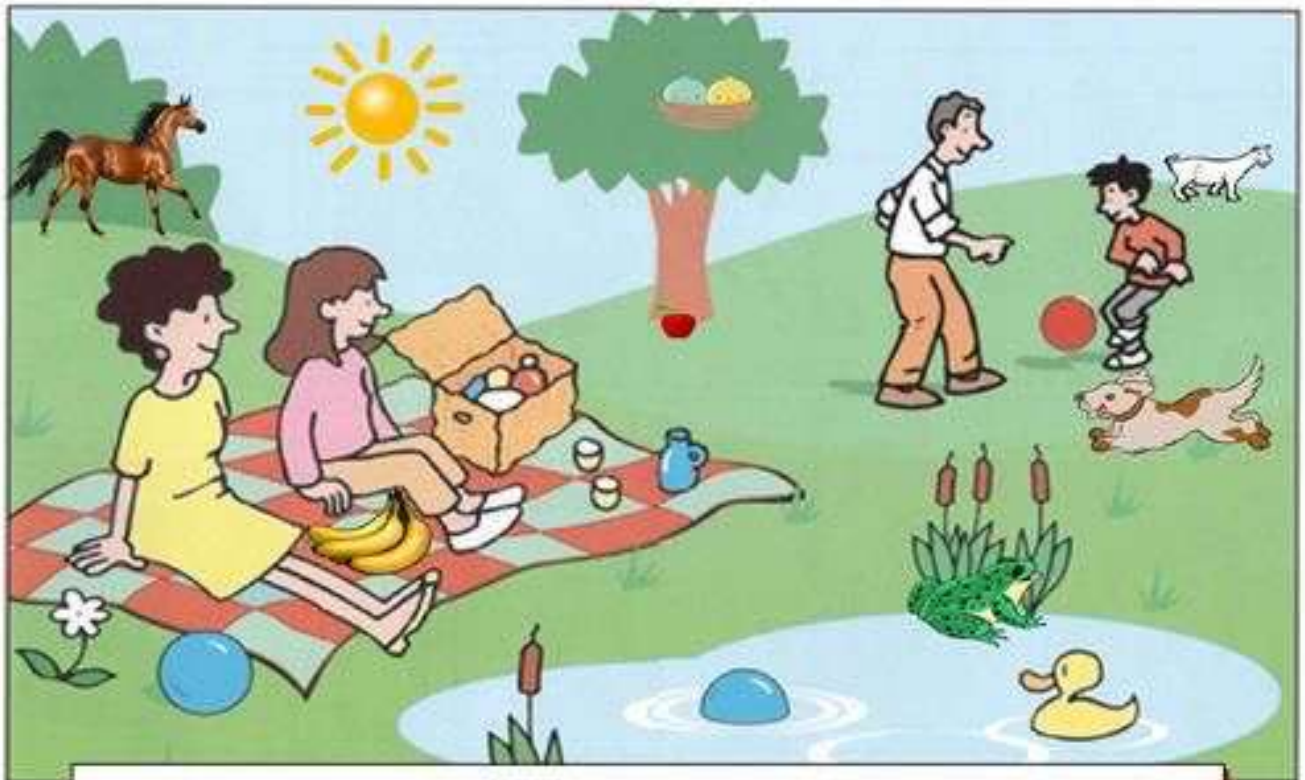


# Picnic in the Countryside.
